



Xograms by Hugh Turvey at Salisbury District Hospital

Appropriately displayed opposite the X-ray rooms, this touring exhibition of Hugh's work is fusion of X-ray and photography that is a new type of Rayogram wherein the object's shadow is not only exterior, but also interior, thus depicting its inner structure and density. He defines these images as 'Xograms' — different from Photograms because of the frequency of the light used to expose the paper.

If seeing is believing then Hugh Turvey, permanent artist in residence at the British Institute of Radiology (BIR), helps us suspend our disbelief. He is an artist looking for transparency in a 'smoke and mirrors' world of spin and media manipulation. He is fascinated by what is hidden and, in focusing on the spaces in between, his Xograms make the everyday appear uncommon, debunking the myth that beauty is only skin deep.

9 Dec 2013 – The third bimonthly internal club competition with a special subject of "Close-up or macro".






